Port of San Diego Air Quality Initiatives

- 2002 Spent \$2.33 million for construction of Dole refrigerated container facility; 511 electric poles to serve refrigerated containers.
- 2005 Awarded \$90,000 EPA grant to retrofit trucks and off-road equipment.
- 2005 Joined West Coast Collaborative.
- 2005 Participated in Goods Movement public working groups.
- 2006 Developed air quality strategy and maritime air emissions management program.
- 2005-06 Negotiating a proposed MOU with SDAPCD to conduct emission inventory for CST, TAMT, and NCMT.
- 2006 Authorized SDG&E to perform a cold-ironing feasibility study.
- 2006 Port staff visited Port of Seattle/Princess Cruise Line cold-ironing facility.
