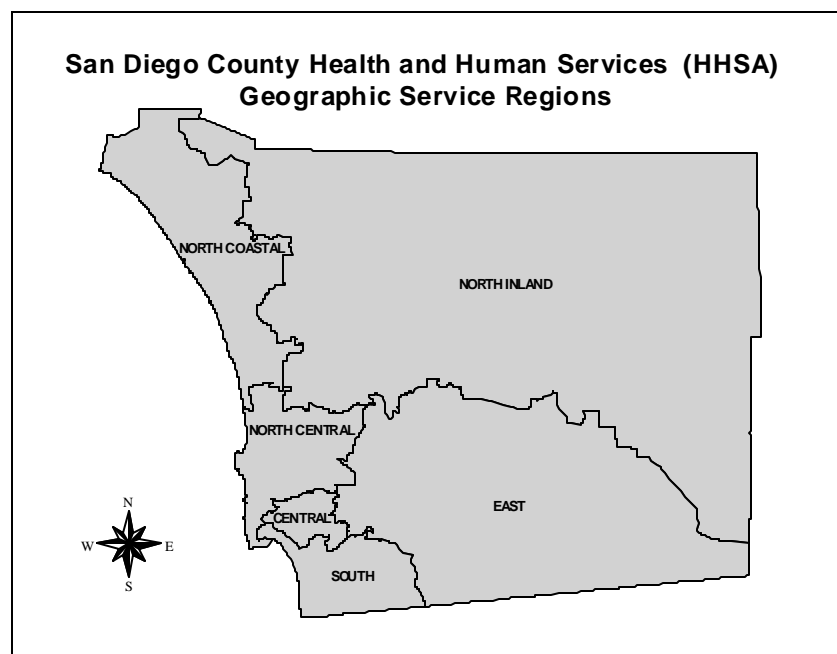

PREFACE

The San Diego County Child and Family Health and Well-Being Report Card 2001 is the first to include a map supplement. The Report Card provides data on 26 measures, which fall into the categories of Economic Security, Good Health, Appropriate Access to Services, A Safe Environment and Educational Achievement. Seven of the 26 measures have zip code level data available and are presented with corresponding maps in this document:

1. Rate of Households Receiving CalWORKs Assistance
2. Percent of Babies Born with Low Birthweight
3. Rate of Births to Teens Ages 15-17
4. Rate of Substantiated Cases of Child Abuse/Neglect
5. Rate of Domestic Violence Reports
6. Rate of Court Cases Filed Against Youth Offenders
7. Rate of Youth Killed or Seriously Injured in Alcohol/Drug-Related Motor Vehicle Crashes Ages 16-20

Maps for each of the seven measures are displayed according to the six geographic service regions of the County of San Diego Health and Human Services Agency (North Coastal, North Inland, North Central, Central, East and South). These maps allow for comparisons both within and between the regions. Each regional section concludes with a summary table that lists both the rate and the number of cases per zip code for each of the seven measures. A detailed table listing zip codes and corresponding areas within the County of San Diego can be found on page 36. As with the overall regional maps in the main 2001 Report Card, rates are based upon three-year averages in an effort to reduce the effect of random variations and fluctuations that may occur when there are a small number of events. One exception to this rule is the child abuse/neglect measure, which is a two-year average. This is due to a change in the definition of substantiated cases of child abuse/neglect that precludes averaging the most current data (year 2000) with previous years.



Caution should be exercised when interpreting the data presented in this document. First, the rate scale for each measure is defined according to natural breaks (groupings and patterns inherent in the data) across four categories. This includes a category representing “fewer than five events” where no rate was calculated because of the inherent instability of rates calculated from small numbers. As a result, the rate divisions vary from measure to measure and from region to region. The legends for each map should be carefully examined before comparisons are made.

Second, the measures had a varying percentage of records with zip codes that could not be matched to a list of valid zip codes obtained from San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG). These invalid zip codes and records with missing zip codes are therefore neither depicted in the regional map nor used in calculations of the overall county rate. The percentage of invalid zip codes is listed in the footnote of each map.

Third, as with the main Report Card, population estimates from SANDAG used to calculate rates have not yet been revised to reflect 2000 census data. Additionally, although the population estimates are available by zip code, they are based on allocation of census blocks and partial blocks into zip code geographic areas. Variation in zip code boundaries used for event (numerator) data and that used for population estimates could have a large impact on rates with a small number of cases. Finally, it should be emphasized that the differences seen in rates between zip codes, either within a region or from one region to another, may or may not have practical public health or programmatic/policy implications. Rate differences should only be one of many factors considered in the decision-making process for resource allocation and program planning.

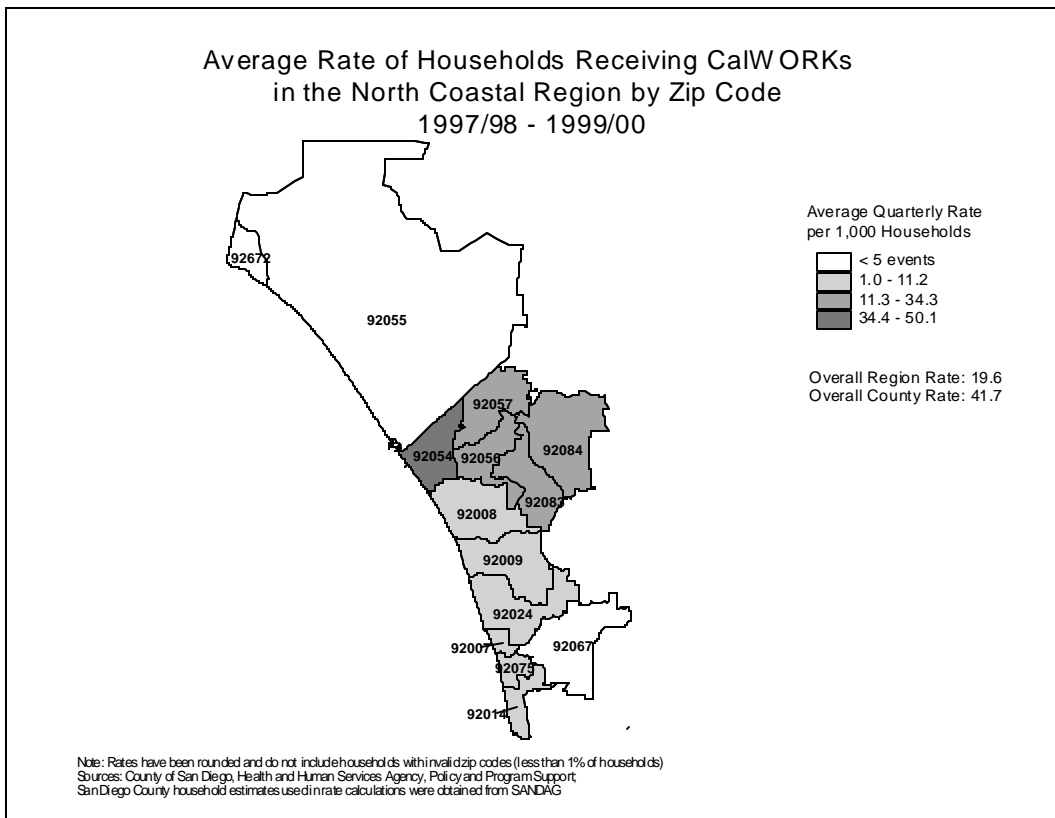
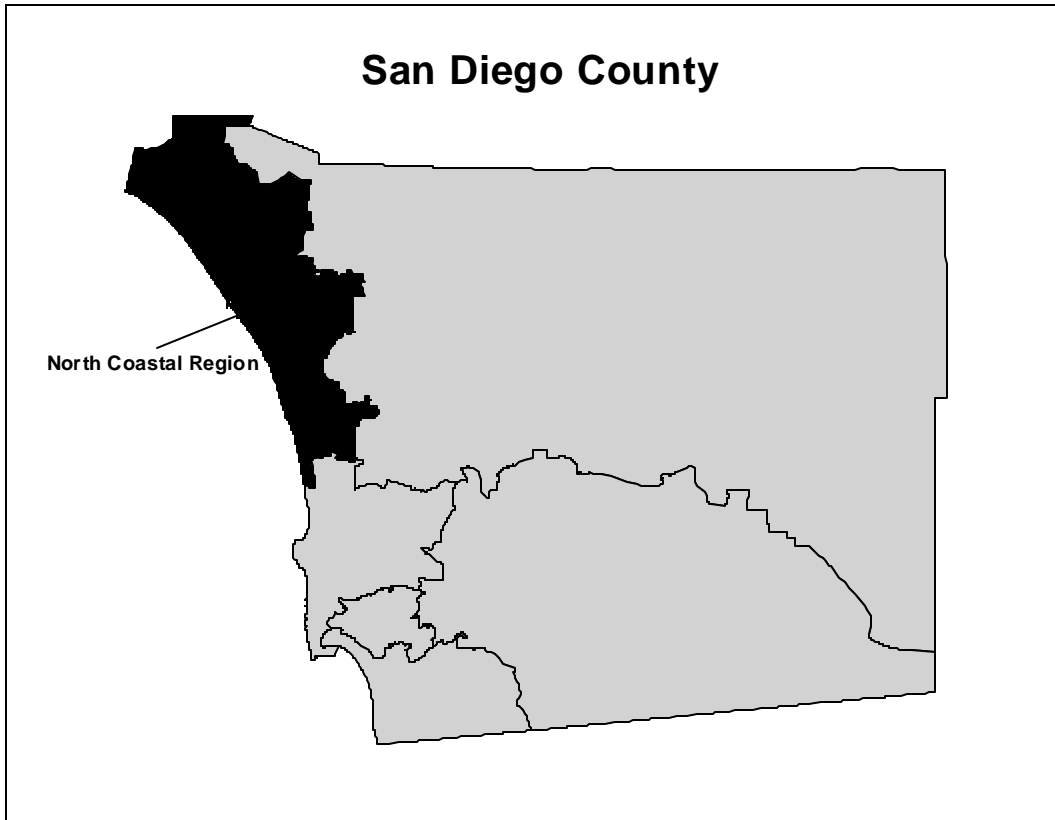
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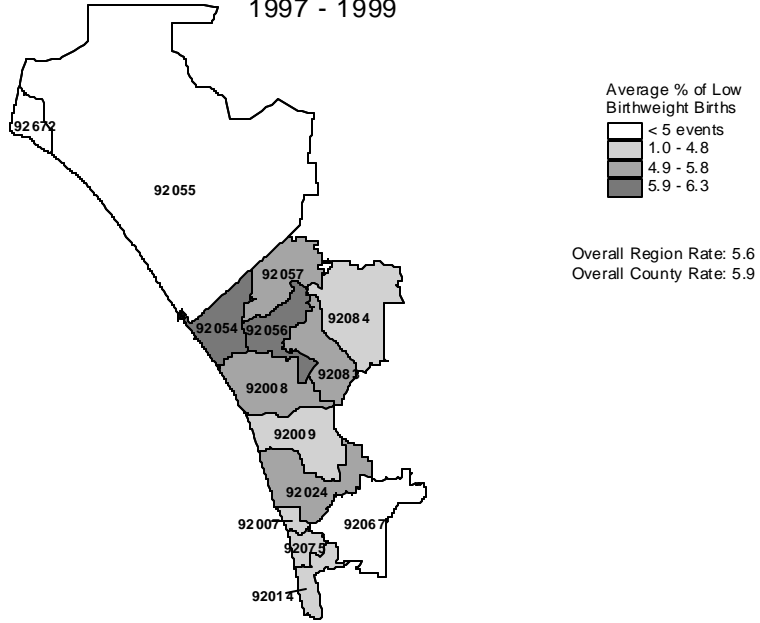

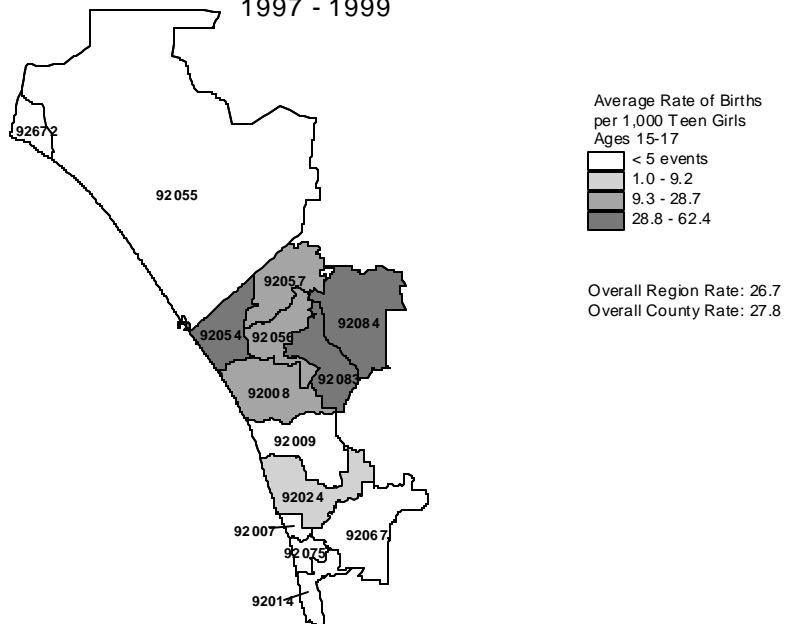


Average Percent of Babies Born with Low Birthweight

1997 - 1999



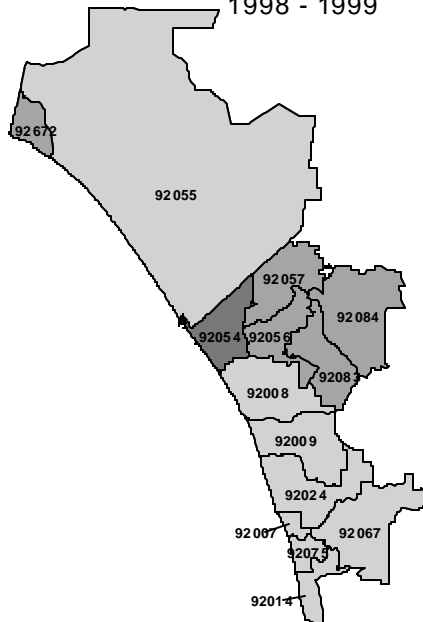

1998 - 1999**



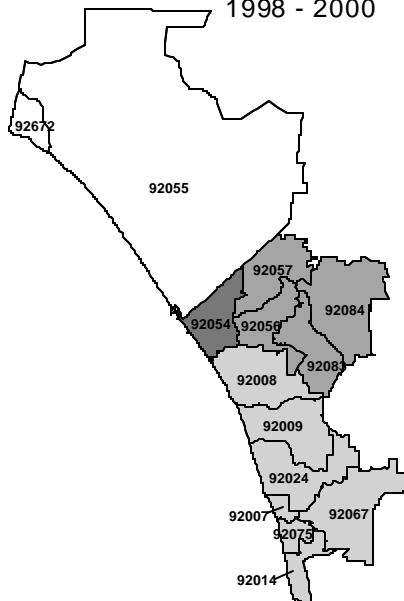

1998 - 2000**



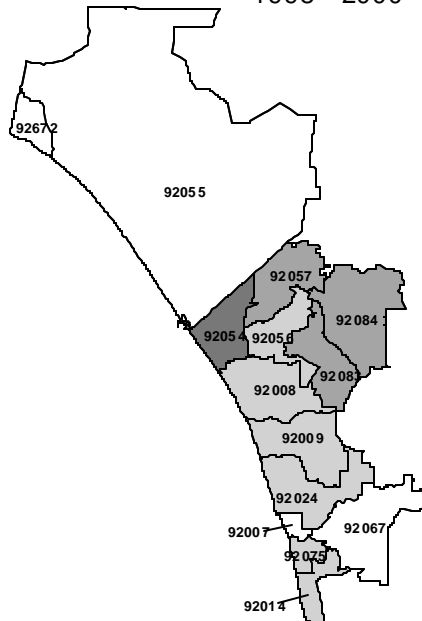

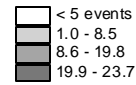

1998 - 2000**



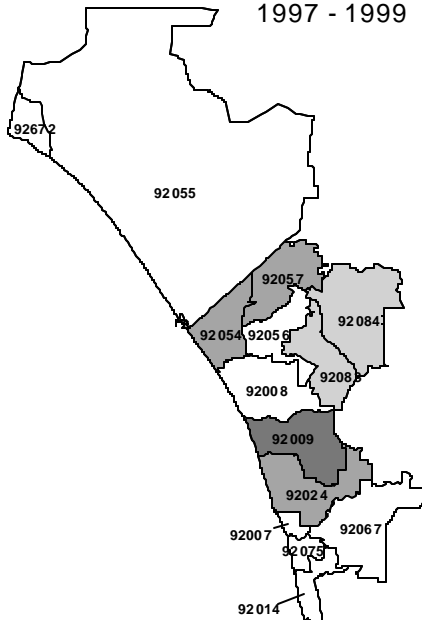
Average Rate of Cases

Ages 10-17



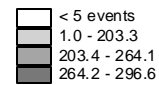

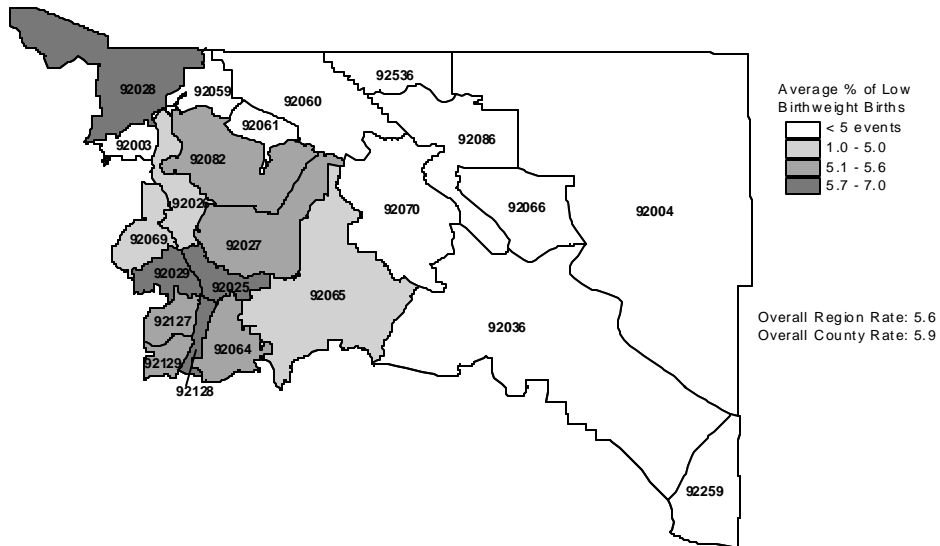

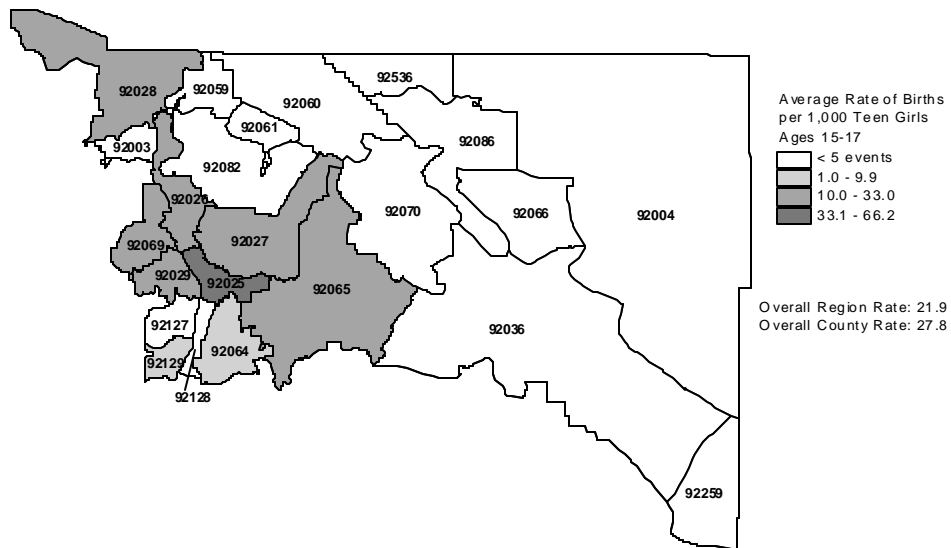


Average Percent of Babies Born with Low Birthweight in the North Inland Region by Zip Code 1997 - 1999



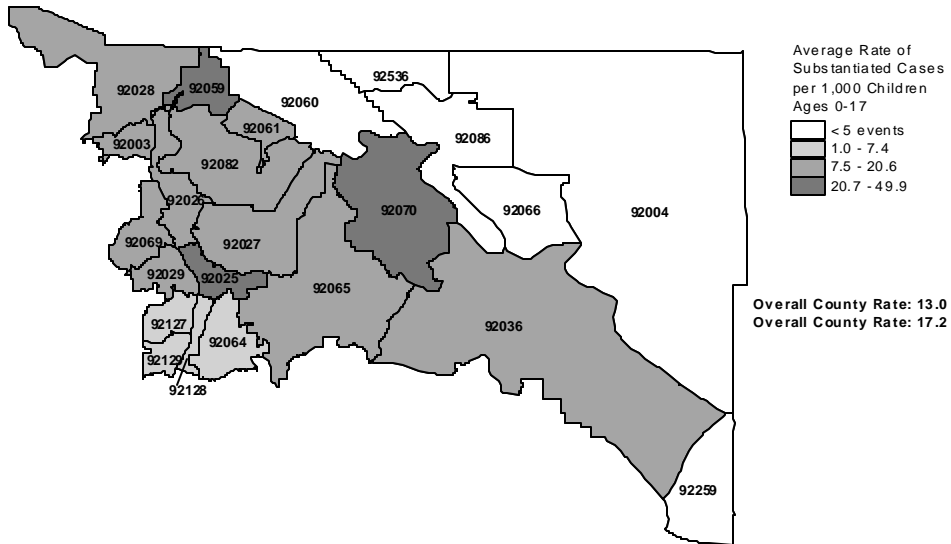

Average Rate of Births to Teens Ages 15-17 in the North Inland Region by Zip Code 1997 - 1999



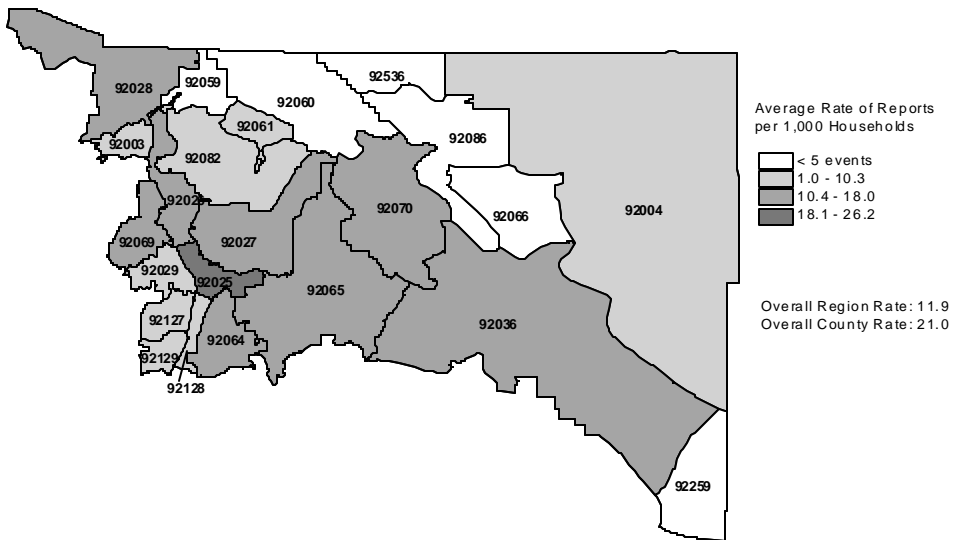

Average Rate of Substantiated Cases of Child Abuse/Neglect in the North Inland Region by Zip Code 1998 - 1999



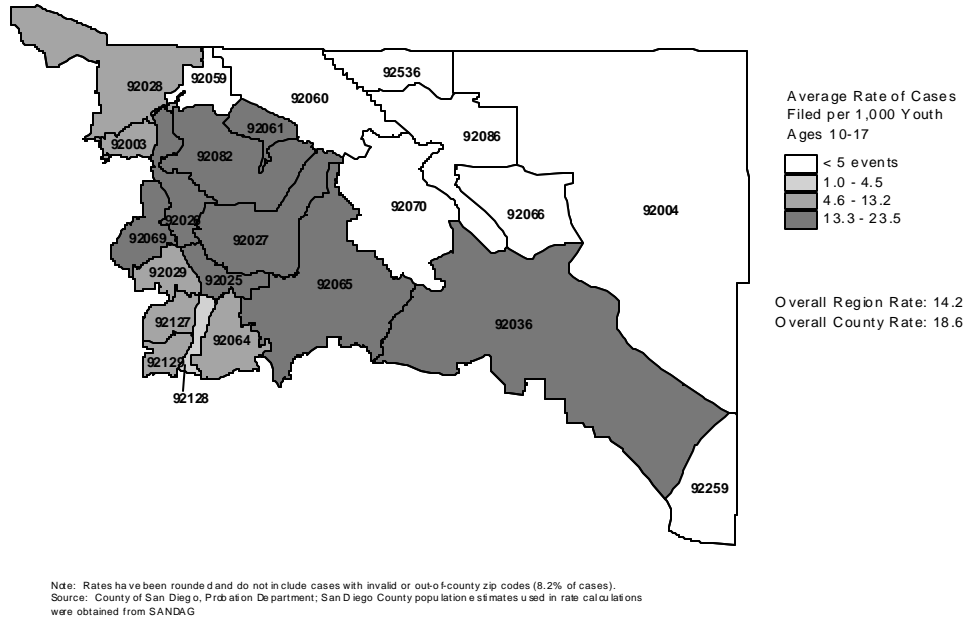

Average Rate of Domestic Violence Reports in the North Inland Region by Zip Code 1998 - 2000

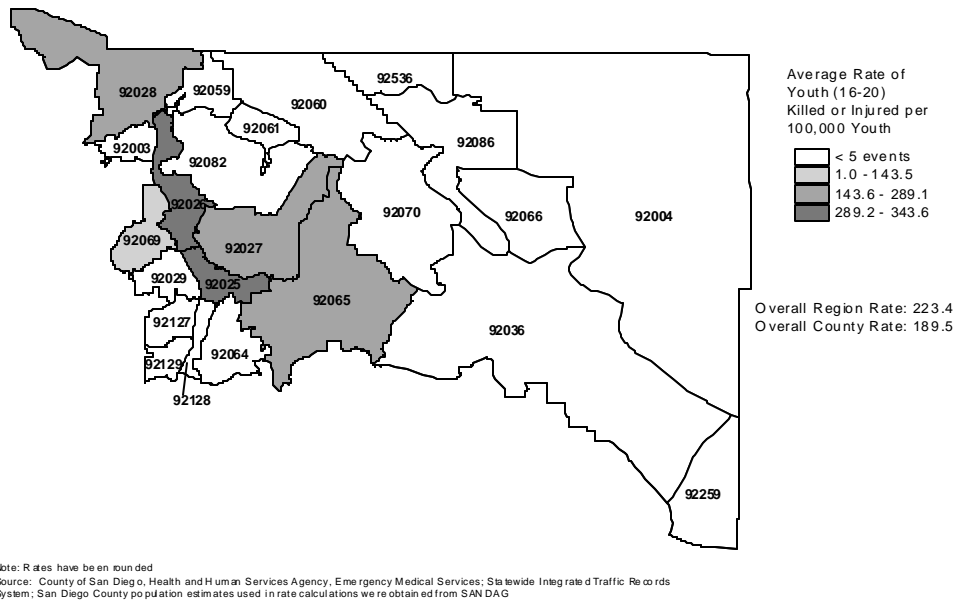

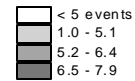

Average Percent of Babies Born with Low Birthweight in the North Central Region by Zip Code 1997 - 1999



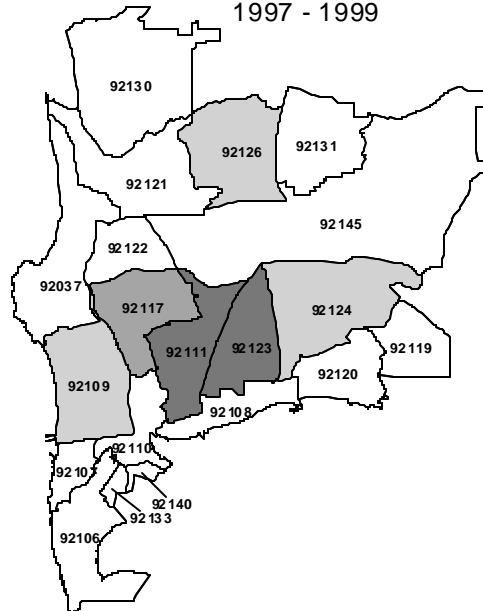
Average % of Low Birthweight Births



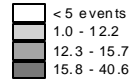

Average Rate of Births to Teens Ages 15-17 in the North Central Region by Zip Code 1997 - 1999



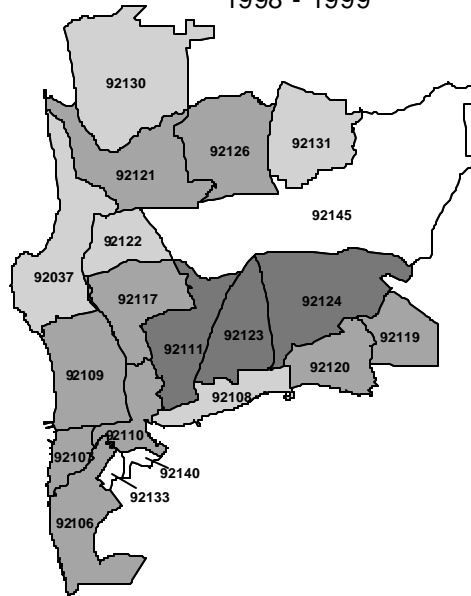
Average Rate of Births per 1,000 Teen Girls Ages 15-17

Average Rate of Substantiated Cases of Child Abuse/Neglect in the North Central Region by Zip Code 1998 - 1999



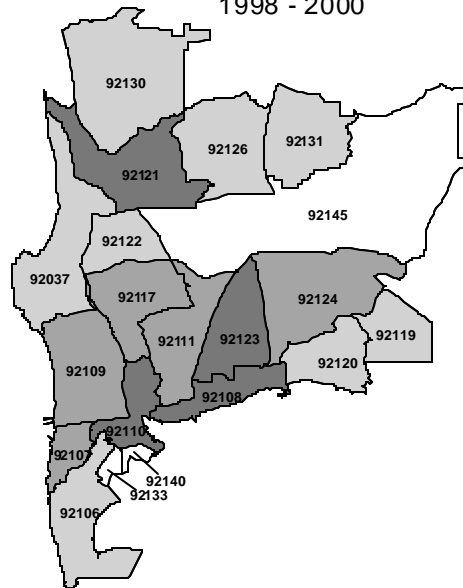

Average Rate of Domestic Violence Reports in the North Central Region by Zip Code 1998 - 2000



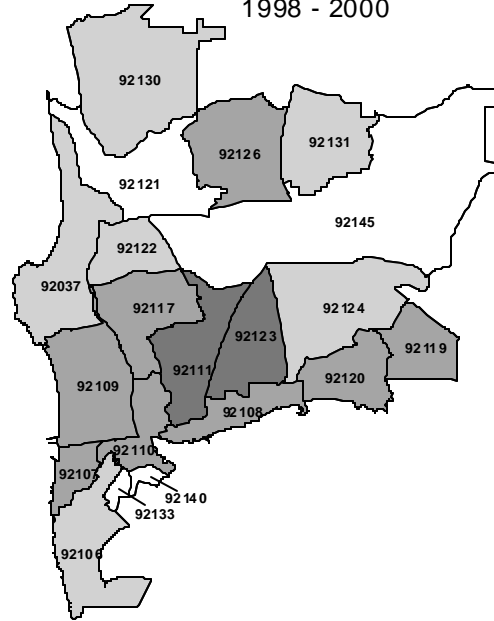

Average Rate of Court Cases Filed Against Youth Offenders in the North Central Region by Zip Code 1998 - 2000

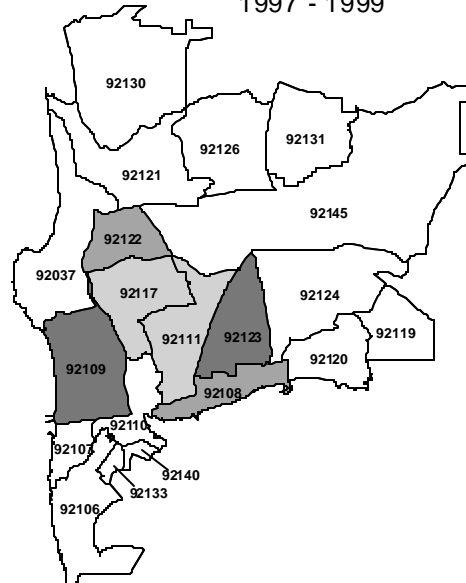

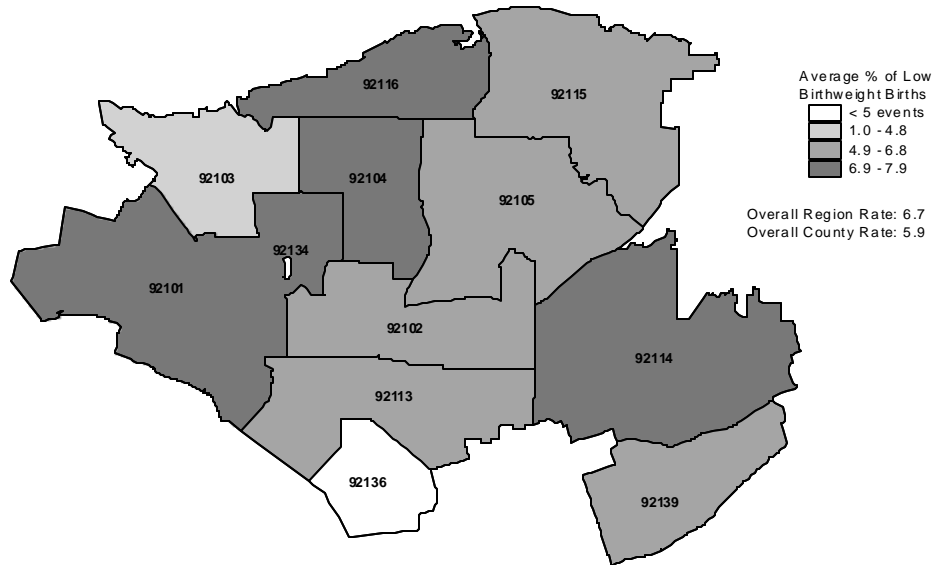

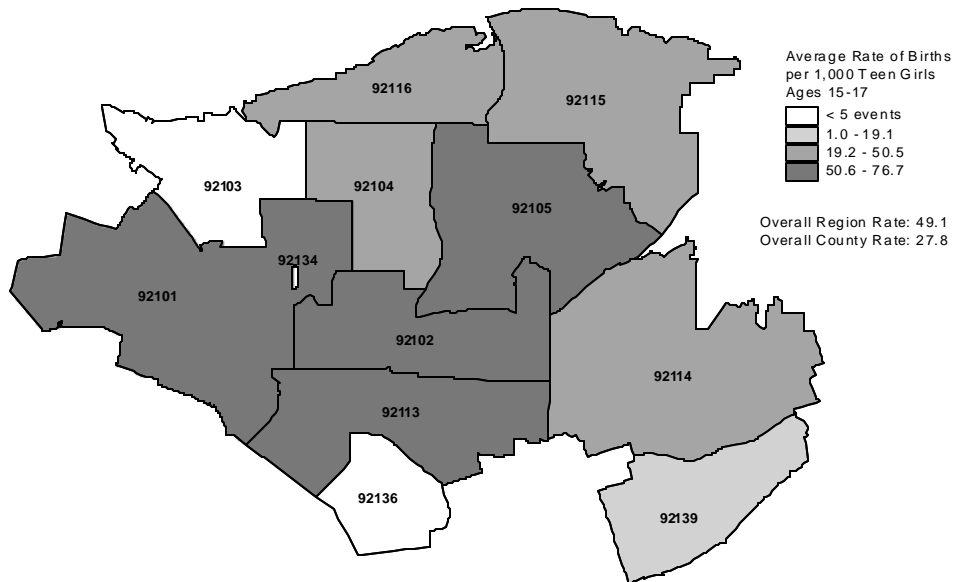


Average Percent of Babies Born with Low Birthweight in the Central Region by Zip Code 1997 - 1999



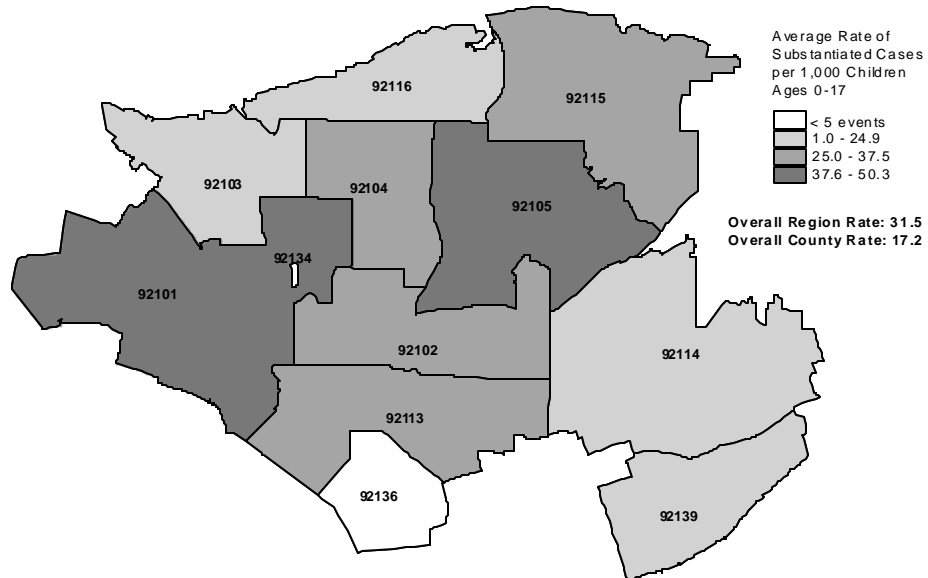

Average Rate of Births to Teens Ages 15-17 in the Central Region by Zip Code 1997 - 1999



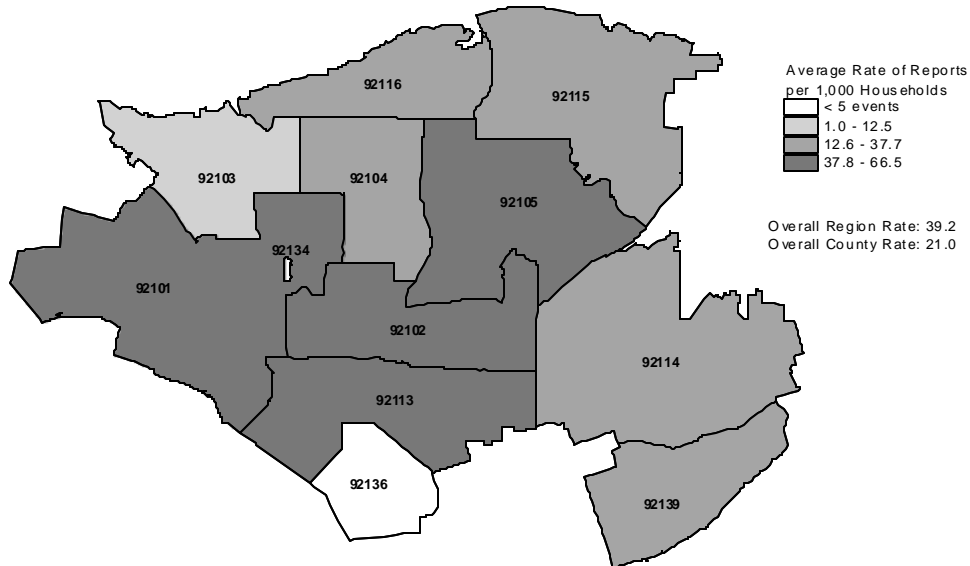

Average Rate of Substantiated Cases of Child Abuse/Neglect in the Central Region by Zip Code 1998 - 1999



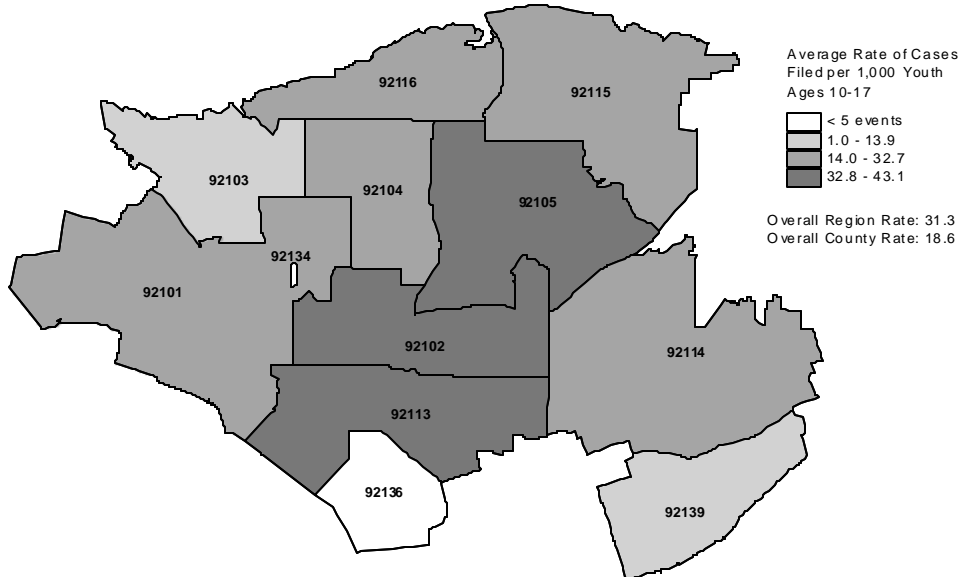

Average Rate of Domestic Violence Reports in the Central Region by Zip Code 1998 - 2000



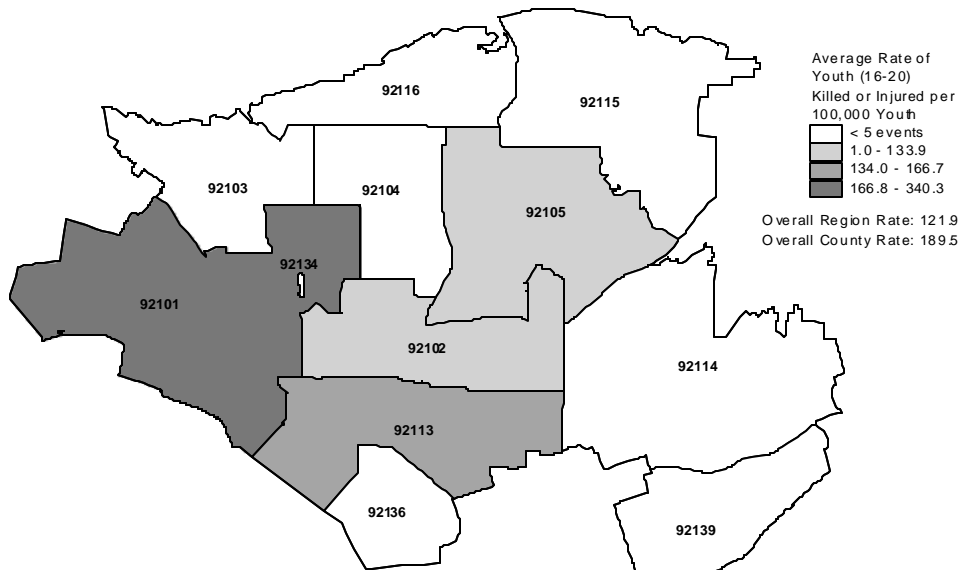

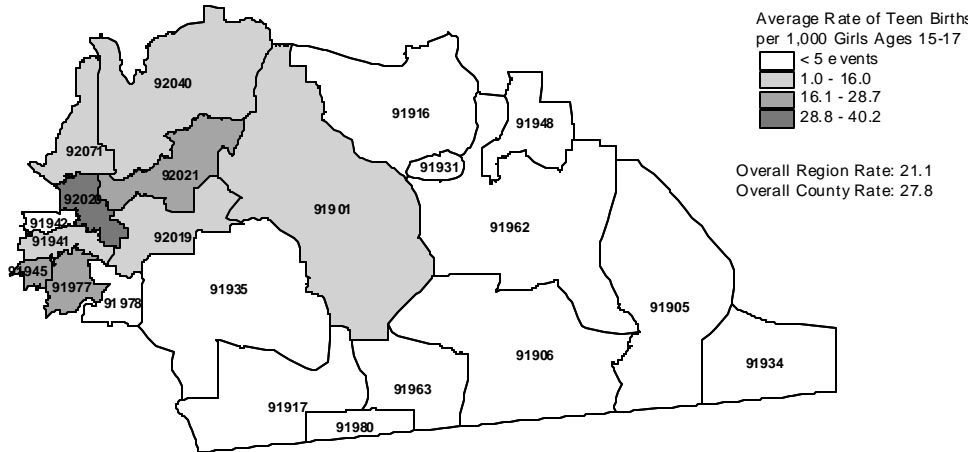


Average Percent of Babies Born with Low Birthweight in the East Region by Zip Code 1997 - 1999



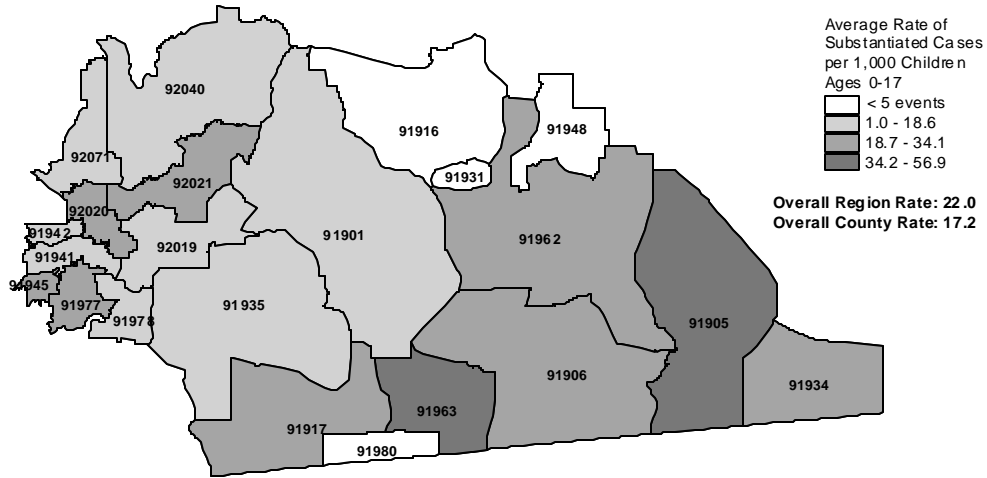

Average Rate of Births to Teens Ages 15-17 in the East Region by Zip Code 1997 - 1999



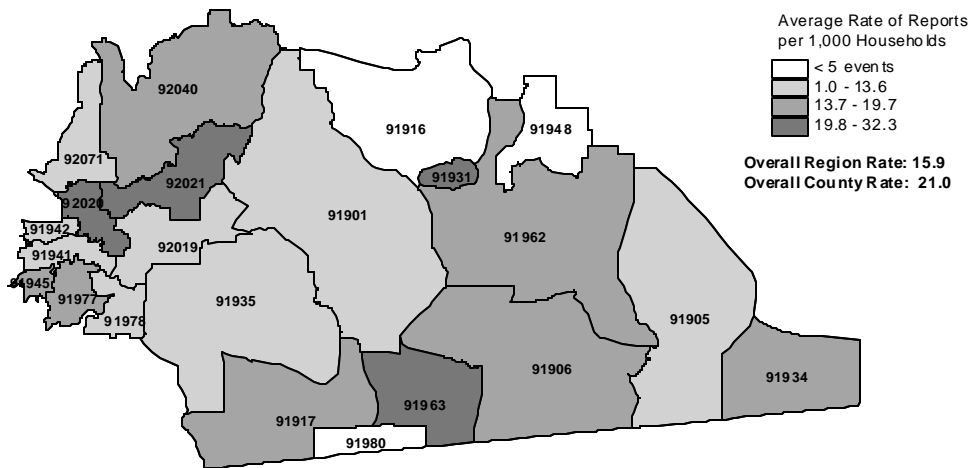

Average Rate of Substantiated Cases of Child Abuse/Neglect in the East Region by Zip Code 1998 - 1999



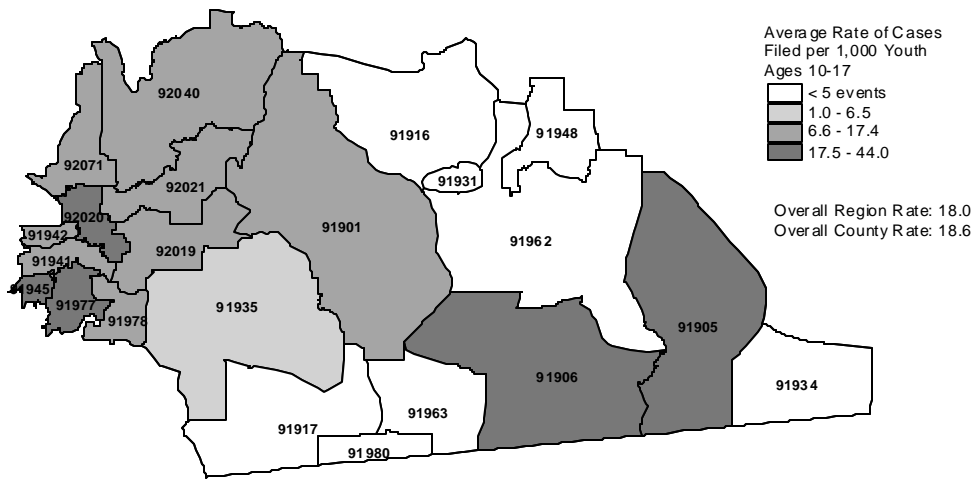

Average Rate of Domestic Violence Reports in the East Region by Zip Code 1998 - 2000



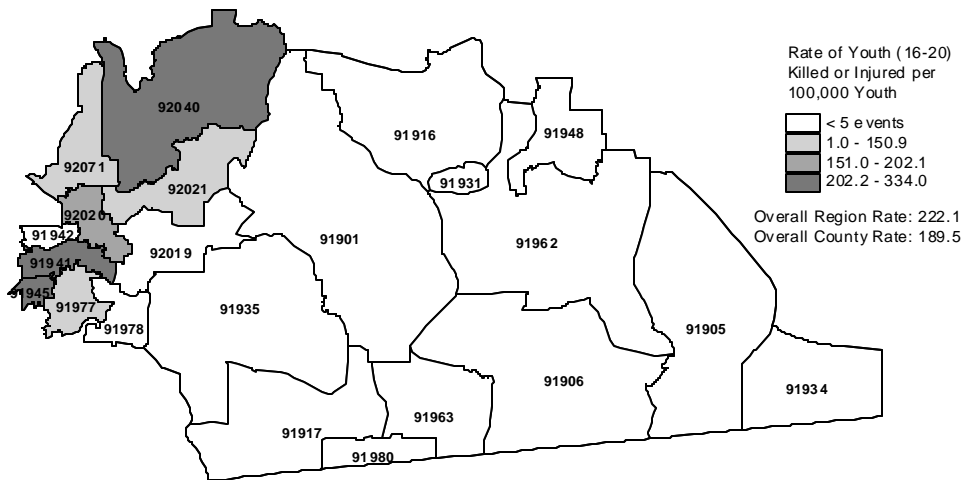

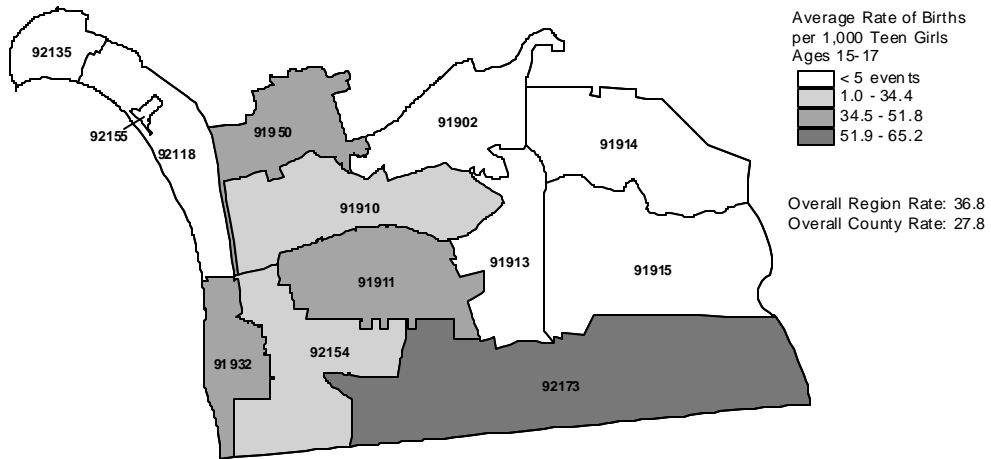


Average Percent of Babies Born with Low Birthweight in the South Region by Zip Code 1997 - 1999



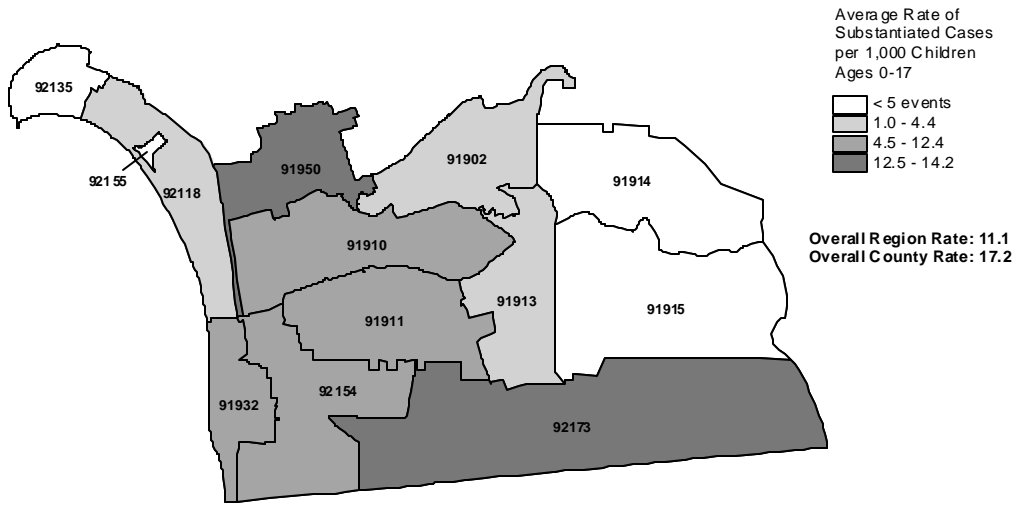

Average Rate of Births to Teens Ages 15-17 in the South Region by Zip Code 1997 - 1999



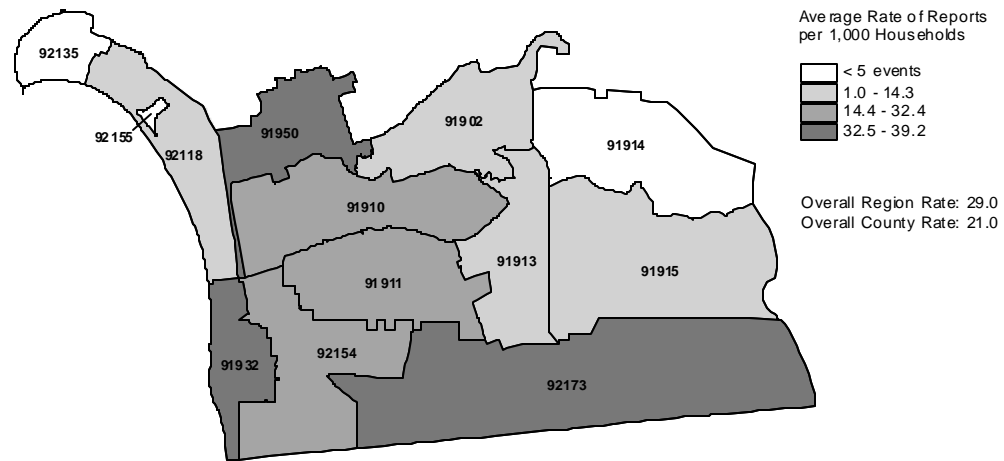

Average Rate of Substantiated Cases of Child Abuse/Neglect in the South Region by Zip Code 1998 - 1999



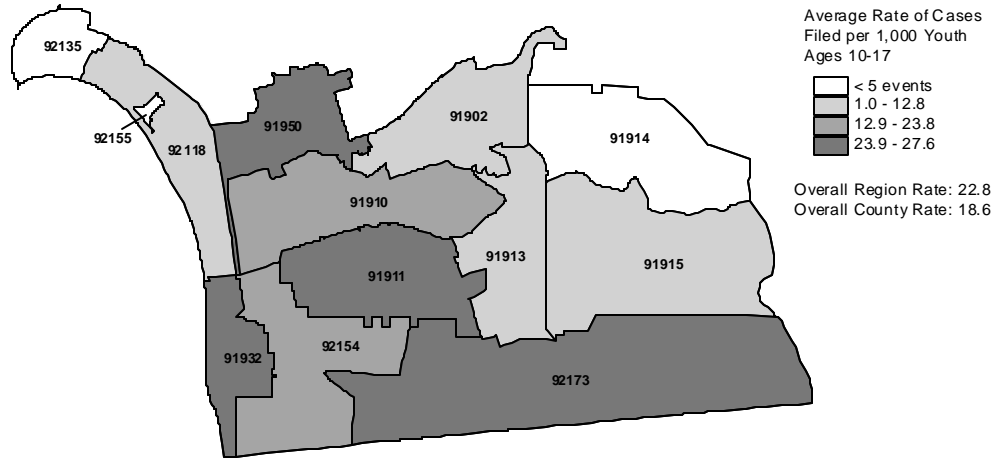

Average Rate of Domestic Violence Reports in the South Region by Zip Code 1998 - 2000



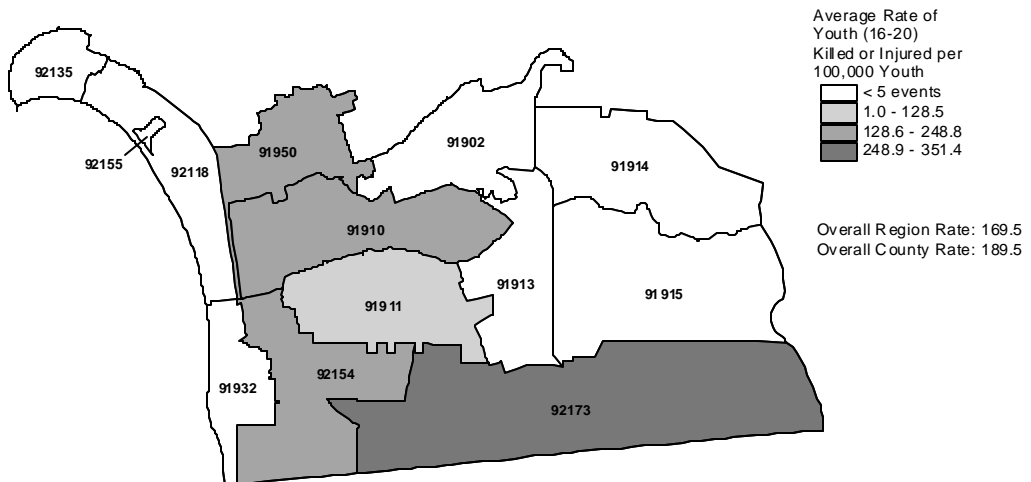
