Based on a comprehensive, year-long community prioritization process, the following health issues top the list:

- Access to health services;
- Social determinants of health;
- Weight status, nutrition and physical activity;
- Injury and violence; and
- Mental health.

Charting the Course provides a resource for the entire community of San Diego County. The report aims to guide individuals, agencies, and institutions in identifying community health needs and concerns and to be the basis upon which community health programs and interventions can be targeted, developed and evaluated. The ultimate goal of the report is to empower the community to improve the health of its members.

During August and September of last year, many of you participated in Regional Forums to provide feedback about some of the root causes of these health issues in your communities. Please join us to hear the results of this exciting process, and to discuss what mechanisms exist to wrap around these persistent health problems as a whole community.
