Greetings Everyone,

Jack E. Johns Fallbrook Family Health Center would like to share some upcoming events with you and your agency. Please help share this information with the public so that they may take advantage of these events and programs.

- Every Thursday from 3-5pm we host iTeen, a teen clinic, for teens 12-19 years old at our clinic. This is a confidential venue to get health information and get health services. - We also currently have a grant from San Diego County Employees' Charitable Organization (CECO) that covers the cost of frames, lenses, and glass cases for persons 19 years or older without vision insurance.
