SAN DIEGO COUNTY TO ISSUE EMERGENCY FOOD STAMPS Families Affected by Wildfires are Eligible for a One-Time Assistance Program

The U.S. Department of Agriculture has approved the issuance of "Disaster Food Stamps" for fire victims in San Diego County.

County residents can begin applying for disaster food stamps on Saturday, Nov. 1, at County *Local Assistance Centers* (see page 2 for locations). Starting Monday, November 3, applications may also be submitted at any *Family Resource Center** from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Residents who are not usually eligible for food stamps may qualify temporarily if their home or belongings were damaged or destroyed and they have disaster related expenses or if they have lost income, food, or money as a result of the fires. Eligibility is based on available income less disaster related expenses. For a family of four, a full monthly allotment is \$471.

Those applying for help should bring a driver's license or other picture ID. Also, they should bring social security numbers for everyone in the household. Applications may be submitted from November 1, 2003 through November 14, 2003.

County residents who are already receiving food stamps may also be eligible for emergency food stamps, if they live or work in the affected fire area.
